NKUST Marine Debris Removal Project: Saving Penghu Waters

According to a report published by the Food and Agriculture Organization of the United Nations (FAO) and United Nations Environment Programme (UNEP) in 2009, there were at least 640,000 tons of <u>fishing gear abandoned</u> and lost at sea per year, <u>accounting for</u> 10 percent of marine debris.

An estimated 800,000 tons of <u>derelict</u> fishing gear (DFG) or ghost gear entered the ocean in 2018. Marine debris is a persistent threat to the ecosystem and wildlife of Penghu Island. In efforts to remove <u>marine debris</u>, Penghu County Government has <u>collaborated with NKUST</u> to remove DFG from nearby waters since 2018.

As of 2020, NKUST Marine Affairs Research Center (MARC) has removed a total of 240,000 meters of abandoned fishing nets.

Chinese Taipei Underwater Federation (CTUF) Chairman Tseng, Ying-Chu appreciated the staff of the project and said: "This project is not that easy. Project workers have to <u>dive</u> into the sea to remove abandoned fishing gears manually. Different <u>waters</u>, certainly, have different conditions and challenges for workers to deal with."

The project has touched a range of new attempts and is certainly a perfect example for future projects.
